Welcome Back Everyone!

We are so excited to be able to announce that we have a return to skating plan and sessions will soon be underway!

Start Dates:

All Prejunior, Juniors, Intermediate, Seniors and Adult Skater Sessions will begin Monday October 5th and CanSkate will start on Monday October 19th - Thanksgiving falls on the Monday prior.

Sessions and Registration:

Registration will be open to last members first until September 30th where we will open up registration up to new members. Unfortunately sessions are capped at 20 skaters due to COVID 19 regulations. We encourage returning members to get their registrations in as soon as possible to ensure their spot.

This year we are offering on line registration to support social distancing protocols. The forms are fillable and you will be able to send the forms back via email. Payments can also be made via etransfer or via credit card. When you send in your registration

Registration Costs:

Because of how the season ended and missing out on two major fundraisers as well as uncertain possibilities for bigger and further fundraising opportunities the prices have had to reflect the costs of ice and coaching per skater. As we are unsure about the avenue and rules around fundraising we do not have a mandatory fundraising fee this season and therefore you see that increase reflected in your fees in order to cover the cost. In order to help support families we are offering four payment installments instead of three.

Fundraising:

Fundraising will still be necessary to cover other incidental costs throughout the year and we will let you know as soon as information is available - so we appreciate and count on your continued support! Keep collecting those empties as we have surpassed our initial goal and are now at \$700. Every bottle counts.

Session Format: (There will be a video posted about procedures)

Dressing rooms will be open with 10 to a room. One parent only per family is to enter the arena.

Parents and skaters are to enter the front doors to the screening table to be checked off and will exit one labelled side doors by the change rooms.

Masks are to be worn in the arena. There will be a designated table with skaters' names. Masks may be removed and placed in a paper bag upon entering the ice if desired. Skaters must bring filled labelled water bottles (refill station is not open).

Water bottles and guards are to be placed in skaters' designated spot on the table.

Due to Skate Canada and COVID regulations there will be no PreCan session offered at this time.

CanSkate will run on 3 circuits only and will have specific entry points once on the ice.

Skaters will use marked entry and exit doors for the ice surface.

New and Exciting: PreJuniors and up will have the opportunity to work on their artistry, transitions from element to element and overall confidence in musicality through mini solos that will be pre-taught in group lessons.

Skaters will have group lessons and private lessons are available. More coaching information to come.
